netball rules

All games will be played according to the **IFNA Rules** apart from specific Bournemouth 7s Rules

- Captains **MUST** attend a netball briefing at Netball Control at 9:45am on the first day of their cup (1:45 for afternoon cups)
- All games are 7 minutes each way with a straight change over
- If a team is late for a game or arrives with less than 5 players it will result in a loss and 5-0 score line
- Substitutions may **ONLY** be made at half time
- Positional bibs must be worn and marked front and back
- Where clubs have more than one team entered, players are permitted to play up a Cup but not down and this **MUST** be pre-agreed with tournament organisers
- If a player plays for any team other than who they are registered for **BOTH** teams will be disqualified
- **ALL** players are required to wear their festival wristband at all times

competition schedule

scoring

- 5 points for a win, 3 points for a draw, 1 point a loss if the losing team score more than half the opponents score
- In the event of a tie on points, section placing will be decided on goal average, goals for divided by goals against
- In the event of a draw in the final, the teams will continue to play until the next goal is scored (Golden Goal)
- Teams are required to provide a scorer (this can be a player) – score cards will be issued by the umpires and scorers will need to stand together.

PLEASE NOTE: Both Captains are **REQUIRED** to check and agree the score with the umpires. The Captain of the winning team should take both scorecards to Netball Control

injuries

- No extra time is allowed for injuries.
- If an injured player needs to leave the court, an appeal to the umpire to halt the game must come from a player
- Replacement players must take the vacant position immediately so that play is continuous
- In the event of a serious injury, common sense must prevail. **DO NOT MOVE THE PLAYER**, alert Netball Control immediately and wait for an official first aider
- If the end of the game is called before play can safely continue, the score will stand at the time of stoppage
- Any player requiring first aid must leave the court and return only when the wound is dressed and after notifying the umpire **OR** a replacement player may take the vacant position immediately so that play is continuous
