## bourne**mouth** 7s festival volleyball information

### volleyball timings and rules

- All games will be played according to the 2017–2020 FIVB Rules of Volleyball, apart from specific Bournemouth 7s Rules.
- Teams **MUST** be ready to start at the times stated within the sporting fixtures.
- 10/15 minutes warm up time will be given before the first round of games.
- A full briefing will take place prior to the tournament commencing to go through all the rules and regulation that sit outside of the FIVB Rules of Volleyball.
- All matches will be played within 25 minute slots.
- The Final will be the best of 3 Sets (15, 15, 11).
- If a team is late for a game it may result in a loss with the game not being rescheduled.
- All teams are mixed with a 4:2 Ratio of Men to Women or Women to Men.
- Volleyball at Bournemouth 7s will be 6v6 and played on grass across 1 court.
- Each squad can consist of 12 players with unlimited substitutions.
- Both Volleyball competitions will be played over 1 day, consisting of a Round Robin and straight Final.
- Teams are required to wear matching tops to ensure no confusion when competing
- Teams will be required to score and officiate when not playing. Please ensure you speak to Volleyball Control regarding your teams officiating times

### scoring

- 3 points for a win, 0 points for a loss, 1 point for a draw
- In the case of a tie on points the team with the best points difference shall prevail and then points scored
- If there is still a tie, the winner of the group match between the tied teams will go through.

### injuries

- No extra time is allowed for injuries.
- Umpires will stop the game for an injury under normal rules which covers blood wounds and replacement players
- In the event of a serious injury, common sense must prevail. **DO NOT MOVE THE PLAYER**, alert the Tournament Manager immediately and wait for an official first aider located near the Volleyball Arena.
- If the end of the game is called before play can safely continue, the score will stand at the time of stoppage.

### player insurance

Players are responsible for sourcing their own insurance should they deem necessary. Bournemouth 7s accept no responsibility for any injury caused by participating in the Volleyball Cups. First Aid provision is available throughout the weekend and can be accessed by contacting the festival organisers.
